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After discussion of the offer of the United States of America to aid by Way of grant in financing the construction of street and highway improvements, the following resolution entitled "A resolution accepting the offer of the United States to Douglas County, Kansas, to aid by way of grant in financing the construction of street and highway improvements" was proposed by Commissioner Earl T. Black and read in full:

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE UNITED STATES TO DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, TO AID BY WAY OF GRANT IN FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF STREET AND HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, as follows:

SECTION 1. The offer of the United States of America to Douglas County, Kansas, to aid by way of grant in financing the construction of street and highway improvements, a copy of which offer reads as follows:

Subject to the Rules and Regulations (PWA Form No. 179, as amended to date) which are made a part hereof, the United States of America hereby offers to aid in financing the construction of street and highway improvements (herein called the "Project" by making a grant to Douglas County, Lawrence, Kansas in the amount of 45 percent of the cost of the Project upon completion, as determined by the Federal Emergency Administrator of Public Works, but not to exceed, in any event, the sum of \$14,463.

SECTION 2. Douglas County agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations relating to such grant, a copy of which rules and regulations, as amended to date, were annexed to the Government's offer and made a part thereof.

'SECTION 3. Douglas County hereby covenants and agrees that work on the project described in the offer will be commenced by December 1, 1936; that the work will be planned so that it will reach a substantial peak before March 15, 1937 and that the project will be completed by November 15, 1937.

SECTION 4. The Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to send to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works three certified copies of this resolution and three certified copies of the proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners in connection with the adoption of this resolution, and such other documents or proofs in connection with the acceptance of said offer as may be requested by the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works Works -
