Mr. E. E. Trueblood, County Engineer, presented the need of more pumps and pumping material and was authorized to equip three wells and to install such equipment at once. The above was authorized by unanimous vote of all the Commissioners.

County Poor Commissioner-Case Supervisor presented the needs of materials for the making of comforters. Earl T. Black moved and Chris Schaake seconded a motion, authorizing Chairman James F. Brass to sign such papers as are necessary in the requisitioning of materials for the making of comforters. The motion was properly put and by unanimous vote of the Commissioners, it was so ordered.

The Trustees of Palmyra Township asked the Board for further grants under the County Blanket for the projects designated as DL 16-2252 and No. DL 16-382. On motion, properly seconded and voted by all the Commissioners, the grants were authorized and ordered.

No further business appearing, the Board adjourned to meet at 10 A. M. December 9.
