The average monthly expenditures for all funds during the 11 months period has been \$7,340.92. We estimate that December expenditures will total between \$8,000.00 and \$9,000.00. The estimated shortage in funds will therefore be between \$5,000.00 and \$6,000.00.

We therefore request permission to issue emergency warrants not to exceed \$8,920.20 which is 25% of the amount levied for the poor fund. Douglas County's valuation on the 1935 tax rolls is \$35,680,830.00.

The Application to your Commission is enclosed with this letter. We should appreciate an early notification of the date for the hearing so that we may publish the notice as required under the law. If possible we should like to have the hearing set for the morning of January 6th, 1937 so that if permission is granted for the issuance of emergency warrants, we could allow bills on the afternoon of that day.

APPLICATION TO THE STATE TAX COMMISSION

WHEREAS it is apparent to a majority of the members of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, that the rates of levy in the taxing district of Douglas County are now so limited as to be insufficient for the raising of funds necessary to supply the needs of said Douglas County for general maintenance expenses for the current tax year and particularly for the expenses necessary for the relief of the poor from the County's Poor Fund, and whereas there is attached hereto a complete schedule showing the County's present financial situation in reference to said Poor Fund and demonstrating the need for the issuance of emergency warrants.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas makes its application to the Tax Commission of the state of Kansas for authority to issue emergency tax warrants in an amount not to exceed 25% of the amount of money that can be raised by taxation in Douglas County Kansas for the current tax year under the existing rates, and that said tax commission grant a public hearing for the purpose of the submission of evidence in support of this application.
