

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

County Attorney, R. B. Stevens appeared before the Board, presenting a resolution advising to cancel a certain contract between the County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas and Harry Frazee, an attorney, under date of October 8, 1936. Said contract purporting to employ Harry Frazee as agent to collect past due taxes from the Kansas City Kaw Valley and Western Railroad Company.

The resolution follows:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS
COUNTY KANSAS, IN THE SPECIAL MEETING ASSEMBLED
ON THE 30th DAY OF DECEMBER, 1936.

WHEREAS on the 8th day of October, 1936, the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, entered into a contract with Harry W. Frazee, for the collection of taxes on both real and personal property and bridge rentals due from the Kansas City, Kaw Valley and Western Railway Company, a corporation, and the receiver thereof, and,

WHEREAS this Board has been notified by Richard B. Stevens, County Attorney of Douglas County, Kansas, that the said contract is void and ultra vires of the Board of County Commissioners;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in special meeting assembled on this 30th day of December, 1936, that said contract so entered into with the said Harry W. Frazee be now and the same is hereby cancelled as of this date, and be it further resolved that the said Harry W. Frazee be notified of this action and that he be directed to take no further action under the same, and that the Kansas City, Kaw Valley and Western Railway Company, a corporation, and its receiver, be notified to pay no monies to the said Harry W. Frazee under the said contract for the reasons aforesaid.

Frazee for any purpose whatsoever which may be due Douglas County from the Kansas City, Kaw Valley and Western Railway Company, a corporation, or from yourself as Receiver thereof.
