That such temporary note be of the denomination of \$2,553.89; that it be payable to bearer; that it be dated the 12th day of January, 1937; that it be due two years after date thereof, but be payable sconer at the option of the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, when funds from the sale of bonds to be issued to pay the costs of such improvements be available therefor; that such note bear interest at the rate of 2 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on the 12th day of January and of July of each year after the date thereof; and read as follows:

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That the Fourd of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, a municipal corporation, for value received, does hereby acknowledge itself to be indected to, and promises to pay to the bearer hereof, the sum of \$2,553.89-in lawful money of the United States of America, on the 12th day of January, 1959, or the due date of the first installment of bonds to be issued for the payment of the improvements hereinafter mentioned, as may be sconer in point of time, together with interest thereon at the rate of 2 per cent per annun, payable semi-annually on the 12th day of January and the 12th day of July of each year after the date hereof, until the principal sum hereof shall be fully paid, both principal and interest of this note being payable at the office of the Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, in the City of Lawrence, Douglas, State of Kansas, is held and firmly bound by these presents, and the full faith, credit, and re-sources of said Board of County Cormissioners are hereby pledged for the prompt payment of said principal, and interest at maturity.

This note is issued for the purpose of evidencing indebtedness incurred and heretofore duly authorized by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas for the making of certain improvements, to-wit, the paving, curbing, grading and drainage of Strong Avenue and Croscent Road, which improvements are to be paid for in part by the issuance of bonds, under the authority of R.S. 60-720, and this note is issued under the authority of and in conformity of the provisions, restrictions, and limitations of the Constitution and Laws of the State of Kansas, and specifically authorized by R.S. 10-125, being of the Revised Statutes of Kansas for the year 1925, and this note, together with all interest to become due thereon, is to be paid by said Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, reserves the right to pay this note at any time prior to the maturity date hereof.
