Authorization, having been given by the State Yam Cormission for the issuance of Emergency Warrants up to 1000.00, was considered. It was suggested that a complete transcript of all deliberations loading up to the issuance of said Emergency Warrants be made. Such transcript, having been rade to the satisfaction of the Attorney for the banks, said C. C. Stewart, the following warrants Hos. 7811 under date of January 21, 1937 up to and including Warrant Ho. 7872, January 31, 1937, as shown on Allowance Record, a copy of which is attached to the transcript, were stamped "County Poor Fund Emergency Warrant" and "Payable through the Lawrence Mational Bank" and were prepared in the usual manner.

Said warrants total the amount of \$5,561.45. (See copy of transcript on file in County Clerk's office under head of County Poor Fund Emergency Warrants.)

It should be added that these warrants were scrutinized and passed in the regular way by the Boarl of County Commissioners.
