At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, held on February 10, 1937, it was ordered that the County Clerk instruct the County Treasurer as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County have considered the apportionment schedule and letter setting forth information concerning the apportionment of a certain \$12,500.00 mortgage registration tax paid by the Kansas Electric Power Company to the Douglas County Recorder of Deeds on December 21, 1936, and submit in response thereto the following recommendation:

That the County Treasurer withhold from distribution the entire fee pending decision of the court in the case of the County Commissioners of Shawnee County restraining the Shawnee County Treasurer from distribution of a similar tax paid by the Kansas Power and Light Company in that county. The question to be decided in the case above cited is one of constitutionality of the law under which apportionment of mortgage registration tax between counties should be made and we feel that it would be advisable to wait for a decision of the courts before making any apportionment of the Kansas Electric Power fee which has been paid in Douglas County and to which the same law of apportionment applies as is now being tested in the case of Shawnee County.
