Section 3. The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas
 County, Kansas, and the Clerk of said County are hereby authorized and directed
 to prepare and execute the bonds hereinbefore described, and to procure their
 proper registration in the office of the County Clerk and in the office of the
 Auditor of the State of Kansas, and, when so executed and registered and rejected
 by the State School Fund Commission, to deliver the same to the purchaser thereof
 upon payment of the purchase price.

Section 4. The proceeds of said bonds shall be placed in the treasury and
 shall be applied for the sole purpose of paying the cost of supervision, engineer-
 ing, inspection, materials, supplies and other expense of public work relief,
 public employment, and public works projects in Douglas County, Kansas, not paid
 for by the State or Federal Governments, provided, however, that no part of the
 proceeds derived from the sale of said bonds shall be applied for the purposes afore-
 said to an extent exceeding twenty-five per cent of the total cost of any such
 projects, including labor, supervision, engineering, inspection, materials,
 supplies and all other expense actually a part of the total cost of such project.

Section 5. The full faith, credit and resources of the County of
 Douglas, State of Kansas, shall be, and the same are, hereby irrevocably pledged
 for the prompt payment of said Public Work Relief Bonds and the interest thereon,
 dated February 1, 1937, hereinbefore described. For the purpose of paying the
 interest on said bonds and the principal thereof as the same shall become due,
 the Board of County Commissioners of said County shall annually levy upon all of
 the taxable property of said County a tax sufficient to produce a fund to pay the
 interest on said bonds and to pay the principal thereof as the same matures.

Section 6. Any and all previous action heretofore taken by the Board
 of the County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, inconsistent with this
 resolution shall be, and the same is hereby repealed.
