## . . . February 26, 1937.

At a special joint meeting of the Commissioners of Douglas and Leavenworth Counties held in the Chambers of the Leavenworth County Commissioners in the County Court House in the City and County of Leavenworth, Kansas, such meeting being called by James F. Brass as chairman of the joint boards, and the following persons being present:

From Douglas County: James F. Brass, Chris Schaake, and Earl T. Black, Commissioners, with Engineer E. E. Trueblood. And from Leavenworth County: Commissioners Lon Rush, Ed. S. Brewster and Sam Warden with Engineer H. G. Simpson, County Attorney Wm. D. Reilly and County Clerk, Thos. J. Cahill.

The purpose of the meeting was relative to the Ide Flow of February 8, 1937, wrocking the existing span of the Eudora Bridge and the question of ways and means of making the necessary repairs as consequence thereof.

Engineer Trueblood described the present condition of the span and the necessity of quick action to properly conserve the interests of Leavenworth and Douglas Counties and what it would require to replace the wrecked span etc.

After some furthor discussion as to what could be done in the premises the matter was disposed of in the following Resolution:
