COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

March 1, 1937,

The Board of County Commissioners met in the first meeting of the regular session of March, 1937, with Chairman Chris Schaake and Commissioners Earl T. Black and James F. Brass and County Clerk U. S. G. Plank present.

City Engineer B. M. Babb presented claim, representing estimated amount due the presentor from the Crescent Road - Strong Avenue Project.

For B. M. Babb, as engineer- - - - \$500.00

Moved by James F. Brass, seconded by Earl T. Black that the above mentioned amount be allowed and recorded for payment. The Chairman put the motion and by unanimous vote of the Board it was so ordered.

Attorney C. C. Stewart, representing the petitioners for the improvements in the paving, curbing, grading and drainage of Strong Avenue and of Crescent Road, appeared before the Board in the interest of said petitioners. He submitted to the Board for its approval the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has heretofore authorised the making of certain improvements in the paving, curbing, grading and drainage of Strong Avenue and of Crescent Road, being roads adjacent to the City of Lawrence, in Douglas County, Kansas, the cost thereof, other than that paid from funds granted by the United States of America, to be obtained from the sale of bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, and

WHEREAS, estimates have now been submitted for work done in the additional sum of \$500.00, for which, payment should now be made.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas issue and sell a temporary note under authority of R.S. 10-123 in the sum of \$500.00 for the purpose of obtaining money with which to pay bills now due on account of said improvements.

That such temporary note be of the denomination of \$500.00; that it be payable to bearer; that it be dated the 1st day of March, 1937; that it be due two years after date thereof, but be payable sconer at the option of the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas when funds from the sale of bonds to be issued to pay the costs of such improvements be evideble therefore that each County. costs of such improvements be available therefor; that such note bear interest at the rate of two percent per annum, payable semi-annually on the 1st day of March and of September of each year after the date thereof; and read as follows:

TEMPORARY NOTE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA THE BOARD OF COUNTY COLMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF KANSAS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

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That the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, a municipal corporation, for value received, does hereby acknowledge itself to be indebted to, and promises to pay to the bearer hereof, the sum of \$500.00 in lawful money of the United States of America, on the 1st day of March, 1939, or the due date of the first installment of bonds to be issued for the payment of the improvements hereinafter mentioned, as may be sconer in point of time, together with interest thereon at the rate of two per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on the 1st day of March and the 1st day of September of each year after the date hereof, until the principal sum hereof shall be fully paid, both principal and interest of this note being payable at the office of the Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, and the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, is held and firmly bound by these presents, and the full faith, credit, and resources of said Board of County Commissioners are hereby pledged for the prompt payment of said principal and interest at maturity. and interest at maturity.

This note is issued for the purpose of evidencing indebtedness incurred and heretofore duly authorized by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, for the making of certain improvements, to-wit, the paving, curbing, grading and drainage of Strong Avenus and Crescent Road, which improvements are to be paid for in part by the issuance of bonds, under the authority of R.S. 68-72B, and thisnote is issued under the authority of and in conformity of the provisions, restrictions, and limitations of the Constitution and Laws of the State of Kansas, and specifically authorized by R.S. 10-123, being of the Revised Statutes of Kansas for the year 1923, and this note, together with all interest to become due thereon, it is to be paid by said Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, reserves the right to pay this note at any time prior to the maturity date hereof.
