NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, makes its application to the State Tax Commission of the State of Kansas, for authority to issue poor relief bonds in the sum of \$20,000.00, said bonds to be issued under and by virtue of Section _____ of House Bill 333 of the Session Laws of 1937 and this commission requests that the said State Tax Commission grant a public hearing for the purpose of a submission of evidence in support of this application.
