The Board of County Commissioners assembled this 5th day of May, with the following named persons present: Chairman Chris Schaake, Commissioners Earl T. Black and James F. Brass and County Clerk T. R. Gerhart.

Parties interested in the Crescent Road Project, namely: C. C. Stewart, Attorney, B. M. Babb, Engineer on said project, M. H. Penny, Contractor, E. E. Trueblood, County Engineer and I. C. Bushong, representing the property owners, met with the Board to discuss the matter of removing the sidewalk on the north side of Crescent Road so as to keep the widening in the center of the road, and to make a new sidewalk to conform to the grade of such road.

After some discussion, it was agreed among those present that the cost of the work pertaining to this new sidewalk should become a part of the Crescent Road project, with the county paying its proportional share and the balance to be paid by the property owners. Another meeting was set for Thursday May 13 for further disposition on this matter.

George Carter again appeared before the Board asking for aid from the county until he could secure work and was able to provide for himself. The matter again was referred to the Case Department.

Gene Glahn of the Manley Insurance Company, presented to the Board a cancellation notice of a surety bond held by U. S. G. Plank, former County Clerk.

E. E. Trueblood, County Engineer and Alva Hodges discussed with the Board the matter of awarding a contract for lubricating oil for the county.

The oil of the Socony-Vacuum Oil Company, on March 10, 1937, was approved on trial upon the condition that the oil was satisfactory, and the County does now find that said oil is not satisfactory, and therefore, they award the contract for oil to the National Refining Company, they being the next regular low bidders, at a price of 45 3/4¢ per gallon in quantity lots.

James F. Brass moved that the National Refining Company be awarded the contract for lubricating oil for the county for the year 1937 at the price of 45 3/4¢ per gallon. Earl T. Black seconded the motion. Chairman Chris Schaake put the motion and all roll call, the Commissioners voted "Aye".

The Poor Commissioner-Case Supervisor Mildred D. Watson and Chief Clerk, Leon G. Abele reported to the Board that they received a notice from M. R. Gill, Real Estate Agent to vacate the house at 1408 Tennessee Street, which is now used by the County for the sewing room and nursery school, because the owner of the property desires to put the house in shape for sale.

Mrs. Watson reported that the MYA boys were working very nicely in the gardens sponsored by the County. She stated that a Mr. Perry Buck, who has been hauling the garden implements to and from the gardens, thought that the county should pay him \$2.00 per month for gasoline for doing the hauling.

The Board advised Mrs. Watson to get in contact with Mr. Ernest Vanek, Administrator of the National Youth Administration for Douglas County, concerning the above matter.
