OF ITS ISSUANCE OF POOR RELIEF BONDS IN THE SUM OF \$20,000.00, PURSUANT TO HOUSE BILL NO. 333 OF THE 1937 SESSION LAWS OF THE STATE OF KANSAS.

ORDER

Now, on this 10th day of May, 1937, comes on for hearing before the State Tax Commission of Kansas, the application of Douglas County, Kansas, for an Order approving its issuance of poor relief bonds in the sum of \$20,000.00, as provided by House Bill No. 333, enacted at the regular 1937 session of the Legislature of the State of Kansas, said county being represented by its county officials.

Thereupon, the county introduced its evidence in support of the said application, and having heard the application and the evidence introduced and being fully advised in the premises, it is, by the State Tax Commission found that all the allegations contained in the said application are true and that it is necessary that said bonds be issued to provide funds for the relief of the poor and destitute of said county.

It is, therefore, by the State Tax Commission of the State of Kansas, considered, ordered and adjudged, that the issuance of bonds in the amount of \$20,000.00 by Douglas County, Kansas, be, and the same is hereby approved and confirmed, the same to be issued and the proceeds derived from the sale thereof to be expended under the provision of said House Bill No. 33 of the 1937 Session Laws of the State of Kansas.
