This bond is one of a series of forty (40) bonds of like date and tenor, excepting maturity, numbered from One (1) to forty (40) inclusive, amounting in the aggregate to Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) issued for the purpose of providing for the care and maintenance of the poor dependent upon the public for support in Douglas County, Kansas, and in full compliance with the provisions, restrictions, and limitations of the Constitution and the Laws of the State of Kansas, including Article 1 of Chapter 10 and Section 39-3a04 O. S. Kansas, 1935, and House Bill No. 333 passed at the 1937 Session of the Legislature of the State of Kansas, and such bonds and the interest thereon are to be paid by Douglas County, Kansas.

And it is hereby declared and certified that all acts, conditions, and things required to be done and to exist precedent to and in the issuance of this bond, have been properly done and performed and do exist in due and regular form and manner as required by the constitution and laws of the State of Kansas, and that the total indebtedness of said County, including this series of bonds, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.
