The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has examined each item as set out in the five foregoing pages carefully, approves the reduction of valuations for the reasons as cited in each group heading, and requests the approval of these reductions by the State Tax Commission.

In answer to the request in your letter of July 6, it is the feeling of our Commission that even though improvements for highways, dikes and other purposes may increase the value of the lands, it will also increase the value of other adjoining properties and that in order to maintain an equalized value for all land owners, these particular reductions in acreage valuations should be allowed.
