Morris, of the Dunne-Israel Company of Wichita, Kansas, were in before the Board, the County Attorney and the County Auditor, in regard to the issuance of the Public Assistance bonds by the County. The contract as presented to the Board is as follows:

To The Honorable County Commissioners,
Douglas County, Kansas.

Gentlemen:

For \$15,000.00 legally issued Public Assistance Fund Bonds of Douglas County, delivered to us in Wichita, Kansas, dated October 1, 1937, and to mature 1000 each year October 1, 1938 and 1939, \$2000 each year October 1, 1940 and 1941, and \$3000.00 each year, October 1, 1942 to October 1, 1944, inclusive., said bonds to be of the denomination of \$1000.00, bearing interest from date at the rate of 2½ and 2½ per centum per annum, payable semi-annually, both principal and interest payable at Fiscal agency, Topeka, Kansas.

WE WILL PAY par and accrued interest.

Subject to action of Tax Commission and State School Fund.

This offer is submitted for immediate acceptance and with the understanding that prior to delivery of the above bonds, you are to furnish us with a complete certified copy of the transcript of proceedings had incident to and in the issuance of the bonds that will evidence the legality of same to satisfaction of our attorney, and to take any further steps that may be required by our attorney to make the bonds fully legal.

We herewith hand you our certified check for \$_____ as evidence of our good faith in complying with the terms and conditions of this bid, which is to apply as part payment of said bonds when the legality of same has been approved by our attorney, and to be forfeited as liquidated damages should we fail or refuse to take up said bonds as above provided. Said check is to be returned to us if this bid is not accepted, or if our attorneys should decline to approve the legality of this issue. In the event the State School Fund Commission shall exercise its option to purchase these bonds, it is understood that you will allow us the sum of \$_____ to cover our expenses in preparing and directing the bond proceedings.

It was moved by James F. Brass that the Board accept the above proposal for \$15,000 bond issue, with the Estes Company and Dunne-Israel Investment Company. Earl T. Black seconded the motion. Put to vote by the Chairman, all Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

There appeared before the Board, M. A. Corrill to confer with the Commissioners and the County Attorney in regard to the compromise of taxes for Carl Graeber and Graeber Bros., now bankrupt. The Board informed Mr. Corrill that they wished to defer their decision until a later date.

In regard to the Lone Star Lake Bond Issue, it appears that no protests have been filed by the electors of Douglas County within the thirty day period from August 12, 1937, such period of time being required by law and in accordance with the resolution and notice published in the official county paper.

Therefore, James F. Brass presented and moved the adoption of the following resolution, authorizing the issuance by Douglas County, Kansas, of its Park Bonds in the sum of \$15,000, pursuant to the provisions of Law. The motion was seconded by Earl T. Black. Upon vote, put by the Chairman, all Commissioners voted in favor of adoption.
