The Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with Chairman Chris Schnake, Commissioners Earl T. Black and James F. Brass, and County Clerk, T. R. Garhart present.

Further bills against the County and from the Relief Department were allowed and ordered paid as per Allowance Record.

was approved by the Board and a check for the amount was presented to Mr. Stewart.

The check in the amount of \$14,400.00, received from the Federal government, was handed to C. C. Stewart for deposit.

It was moved by Earl T. Black that the bills be allowed for the Strong Avenue Crescent Road project for payment to the First National Bank as above stated.

The Board adjourned to meet as a Board of Social Welfare, said meeting taking place in the Social Welfare Department. Later, the Board reconvened as a Board of County Commissioners in their regular meeting room.

Having received authority from the State Tax Commission to issue poor relief bonds in an amount not to exceed \$15,000, they duly passed the following resolution:

## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE FUND BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, KANSAS, IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000.00)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has heretofore found and declared, and does hereby find and declare that additional revenue will be needed by Douglas County, Kansas, for the care and maintenance of the poor dependent upon the public for support in Douglas County, in the immediate future, and,

WHEREAS, the State Tax Commission of the State of Kansas on the 11th day of October, 1937, approved the issuance by Douglas County, Kansas, of its Public Assistance Fund Bonds in the principal sum of \$15,000, for the purpose of providing funds for the care and maintenance of the poor dependent upon the public for support in said County, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 244 of the 1937 Session Laws of the State of Kansas, and

WHEREAS, no Public Assistance Fund Bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, have heretofore been issued by said County under the provisions of Chapter 244 of the 1937 Session Laws of Kansas, and under the provisions of Chapter 192 L-1935, except:

AND WHEREAS, the total amount of bonds issued under the above provisions does not exceed one-third of one per cent (1/3 of 1%) of the assessed valuation of Douglas County, including the following described bonds, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, do hereby find, declare and determine that it is necessary that bonds of said County be issued sold and delivered forthwith in the principal amount of \$15,000 for the purpose of providing funds for the care and maintenance of the poor dependent upon the public for support in said county,
