

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular meeting duly assembled:

Section 1. That for the purpose of providing funds for the care and maintenance of the poor dependent upon the public for support in said County, there shall be issued, and hereby are issued, Public Assistance Fund Bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, in the principal sum of \$15,000. Said issue shall consist of fifteen bonds, numbered from One to Fifteen, inclusive; each of said bonds being in the sum of \$1,000. All of which bonds shall be dated October 1, 1937, and said bonds shall become due serially as follows:

Said bonds numbered One to Six shall bear interest at the rate of Two and one-fourth per cent (2 $\frac{1}{4}$ %), and bonds numbered Seven to Fifteen shall bear interest at the rate of Two and One-Half per cent (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ %) per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of April and October in each year. Both principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the office of the State Treasurer of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeka, Kansas.

Said bonds shall be in substantially the following form:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, for value received hereby acknowledges itself to be indebted and promises to pay to the bearer the sum of

ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS

in lawful money of the United States of America, on the first day of October, 1938, with interest thereon at the rate of Two and One-Fourth per cent (2 $\frac{1}{4}$ %) per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of April and of October of each year after the date hereof, until said principal sum shall have been paid, upon presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto annexed, bearing the facsimile signatures of the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk of said Douglas County, Kansas, as said coupons severally become due, both principal and interest of this bond being payable at the office of the State Treasurer of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeka, Kansas. And said County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, is held and firmly bound by those presents, and the full faith, credit and resources of said County are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of said principal and interest at maturity.

This bond is one of a series of Fifteen (15) bonds of like date and tenor, excepting as to maturity and interest rate, numbered from One (1) to Fifteen (15) inclusive, amounting in the aggregate to Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000), issued for the purpose of providing for the care and maintenance of the poor dependent upon the public for support in Douglas County, Kansas, and in full compliance with the provisions, restrictions and limitations of the constitution and laws of the State of Kansas, including Sections 10-101 to 10-116, inclusive and Section 39-3a04 G. S. Kansas 1935, and all acts amendatory supplemental thereto, and Chapter 244 of the 1937 Session Laws of the State of Kansas, and such bonds and interest thereon are to be paid by Douglas County, Kansas.

And it is hereby declared and certified that all acts, conditions and things required to be done and to exist precedent to and in the issuance of this bond, have been properly done and performed and do exist in due and regular form and manner as required by the constitution and laws of the State of Kansas, and that the total indebtedness of said County, including this series of bonds, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, The said County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, by its Board of County Commissioners, has caused this bond to be signed by its Chairman of said Board and attested by the County Clerk of said County, and the seal of said County to be hereto affixed, and the coupons hereto attached to be signed with the facsimile signatures of said officers, and this bond to be dated this first day of October, 1937.
