Mr. George Bahnmeier, Trustee of Lecompton Township, appeared before the Board seeking permission for Lecompton Township to work under the County's Blanket Project to the extent of \$3436.10, and the following Resolution was adopted:-

RESOLUTION

Whereas Plans and surveys are complete, and a proposal has been prepared on WPA form No. 301 for surfacing 2 3/4 miles of Lecompton Township roads with crushed stone at the rate of 600 cubic yards per mile;

And Whereas the Lecompton Township Board has agreed to furnish all Sponsor's funds as indicated in Column 3 under Item 4 of the attached proposal:*

NOW, therefore, Be it Resolved by the Douglas County Board of County Commissioners, in regular session assembled, that Lecompton Township be permitted to operate this project under the County Blanket Road Project.
