The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session on the 5th day of January, 1938, Mr. Chris Schaake, Chairman, Commissioners Earl T. Black and James F. Brass, and Mr. T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk, being present.

On motion of Commissioner Earl T. Black, seconded by Commissioner James F. Brass, the following Resolution was unanimously adopted:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, heretofore petitions were filed, asking for the paving and otherwise improving of the following roads adjacent to the City of Lawrence, in Douglas County, Kansas:

West Hills Parkway, extending from the end of the present pavement at the intersection of West Hills Parkway with West Hills Terrace west to the west line of Emery Road;

Emery Road, extending from the north line of University Drive to the south line of West Hills Parkway;

Stratford Road, extending from the west line of Lot 3, in Block 2, to the east line of Emery Road, all being in West Hills, adjacent to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas; and

University Drive, extending from the west line of West Campus Road to the west line of Strong Avenue,

and

West Hills Road and Adjacent Roadways.

WHEREAS, thereafter the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, did adopt resolutions, as provided by law, finding that it was necessary to pave, grade, curb, and drain such roads, as above described, provided federal funds.could be obtained for the purpose of defraying a portion of the cost thereof, and

WHEREAS, such resolutions were published according to law, the last publication thereof being the 25th day of November, 1937, and

WHEREAS, twenty days' time has elapsed since the last publication of such resolutions and no protest has been filed against the making of such improvements, and

WHEREAS, under date of December 24, 1937, Federal Aid was granted for the purpose of defraying a portion of the cost thereof, said project having been given the designation of "West Hills Road and Adjacent Roadways, Work No. W.P.A. 6346,"

NOW, Therefore, <u>Be it Resolved</u> that such roads be paved and otherwise improved, as described therein, according to the plans and specifications approved by The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, and that the cost of such project, other than that paid by federal and other aid, be paid according to the provisions of Section 68-728 of the General Statutes of Kansas for 1935, and

That a single contract for the construction of all of such improvements shall not be made, but contracts for various items of such improvement be made from time to time, or the work be done by the county or other governmental units, as may, from time to time, seem best.

Commissioner Black moved that, Whereas B. M. Babb, Engineer in Charge, has filed estimates for the cost of paving and otherwise improving roads in West Hills, adjacent to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, and officially designated as "West Hills Roads and Adjacent Roadways, Work No. W.P.A. 6346," which estimates show the total estimated cost of said project to be the sum of \$23,725.53, said estimate be approved.

The motion, seconded by Commissioner Brass; on being put to vote, carried unanimously.

It was moved by Commissioner Black, seconded by Commissioner Brass, that the following Resolution, together with the notes mentioned and the form thereof, be approved, and the notes executed and registered, according to law.

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, has heretofore authorized the making of certain improvements in the paving, curbing, grading, and drainage of West Hills Parkway, Emery Road, Stratford Road, and University Drive, as defined in the petitions and resolutions pertaining thereto, being roads adjacent to the City of Lawrence, in Douglas County, Kansas, and outside the limits of any incorporated city, said Douglas County having a population of more than 20,000 inhabitants, the cost of such improvements, other than that paid from funds of the United States of America, such project being designated as "West Hills Roads and Adjacent Roadways, Work No. W.P.A. 6346," to be obtained from the sale of bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, and
