The Board of County Commissioners repaired to the offices of the Social Welfare Department to sit as a Board of Welfare with the County Director and the Home Visitors.

The County Director, Mrs. Watson, reported to the Board that the State Personnel Supervisor and District Supervisor had recently visited the County Welfare Office, and analyzed the program in regard to workers. They recommended an increase of two Home Visitors and adequate stenographic help in **view** of the heavy case load each worker is now carrying.

The program was given considerable discussion by the Board. The application of Miss Diendonnee M. Roberts was submitted for the position of Trainee, Home Visitor. After due consideration, Earl T. Black moved that Miss Roberts' application be accepted as a Trainee, Home Visitor at the wage of \$50.00 per month, and that a resolution to that effect be sent to the State Board. James F. Brass seconded the motion, and upon proper vote, the motion carried.

The resolution follows:

RESOLUTION

Appointing Diendonnee M. Roberts as Trainee, Home Visitor of the County Social Welfare Board of **D**ouglas County and prescribing compensation. A copy of the personal application record sheet of Diendonnee M. Roberts is attached hereto.

Whereas, the County Social Welfare Board has determined that Trainee, Diendonnee M. Roberts is a porson properly qualified for her duties:

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the County Social Welfare Board of Douglas. County, Kansas in regular session assembled:

That Diemdonnee M. Roberts be and is hereby appointed as Traince, Home Visitor, in the office of the County Social Welfare Board of Douglas County, Kansas, to hold office at the pleasure of said Board.

Be it further resolved that the total compensation of said Trainee, Diendonnee M. Roberts shall be \$50.00 per month, all or part of which may be paid from such available funds, that said employee is properly qualified for the duties of such position as required by the State Board of Social Welfare of Kansas, in cooperation with any of the various agencies of the Federal Government, under the laws of State of Kansas and the United States of America and/or rules and regulations prescribed by the State Board of Social Welfare of Kansas.
