Be it further resolved that the total compensation of Said Trainee, Erna R. Corey shall be \$50.00 per month, all or part of which may be paid from funds as prescribed by law, provided that before said employee may be paid from such available funds, that said employee is properly qualified for the duties of such position as required by the State Board of Social Welfare of Kansas, in cooperation with any of the various agencies of the Federal Government, under the laws of the State of Kansas and the United States of America and/or rules and regulations prescribed by the State Board of Social Welfare of Kansas.
