

After some discussion with the County Auditor on the over-expenditure of the budget for the Bridge and Fairs Funds, the following resolution was passed:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did pass and approve in legal form, a budget of expenditures for the year 1937 for the Bridge Fund and the Fairs Fund respectively, as follows:

Bridge Fund	\$23,000.00
Fairs Fund	\$ 1,200.00

and,

WHEREAS, with no intent to create indebtedness in excess of the budget, warrants were allowed and charged against the budget in excess of the budget in amounts as follows:

Bridge Fund	\$239.75
Fairs Fund	\$ 40.65

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in order to correct this over-expenditure of the budget appropriated for the Bridge and Fairs funds, the said Board of County Commissioners hereby authorize and direct the County Clerk to decrease the 1938 budget for the funds by the amount of excess allowances for 1937.
