

## COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, when funds from the sale of bonds to be issued to pay the cost of such improvements are available therefor; that said notes bear interest at the rate of three per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on the day of August and of February of each year after the date thereof and that said notes shall be substantially in forms as follows:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, a municipal corporation, for value received, does hereby acknowledge itself to be indebted to, and promises to pay to the bearer hereof the sum of \$1000.00 in lawful money of the United States of America, on the 6th day of August, 1940, or the due date of the first installment of bonds to be issued for the payment of the improvements hereinafter mentioned, as may be sooner in point of time, together with interest thereon at the rate of three per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on the 6th day of August and 6th day of February of each year after the date hereof, until the principal sum hereof shall be fully paid, both principal and interest of this note being payable at the office of the Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, and the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, is held and firmly bound by these presents, and the full faith, credit, and resources of said Board of County Commissioners are hereby pledged for the prompt payment of said principal and interest at maturity.

This note is one of a series of notes numbered one to ten consecutively and is issued for the purpose of evidencing indebtedness to be incurred and to be duly authorized by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas for the making of certain improvements to wit: the paving, grading, curbing, guttering and otherwise improving of 19th Street and Barker Avenue, which improvements are to be paid for in part by the issuance of bonds under authority of C.S. 14-541, and this note is issued under the authority of and in conformity with the provisions, restrictions and limitations of the constitution and laws of the State of Kansas, and specifically authorized by Section 10-123 of the General Statutes of Kansas, for the year of 1935, and this note together with all interest to become due thereon, is to be paid by said Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, reserves the right to pay this note at any time prior to the maturity date hereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, has caused this note to be signed by its Chairman and attested by its Clerk, and dated this 6th day of August, 1938.

That such notes be executed on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, by Chris Schaaake, as Chairman, and attested by T. R. Gerhart, as Clerk, and, when so signed and attested, become general obligations of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, and

That such notes shall when registered according to law be sold at not less than par and accrued interest, and shall be sold from time to time as funds are needed for said improvements.

The salary bill of George Price came on for consideration of said Board, and after some discussion, the claim was allowed in the amount of \$71.63.

The Board made a trip to the tomato project for an inspection thereof; then returned to the Court House for further business.

On motion, properly second and voted, the Board adjourned to meet as a Board of Canvassers Tuesday, August 9, 1938.
