As per adjournment, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, met this day in the regular meeting rooms of said Board, with all members and the County Clerk present.

The following resolution was presented to the Board by John E. Stephens, Assistant County Engineer:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Palmyra Township desires to secure the assistance of the Works Progress Administration on a Grading, Surfacing, and Drainage project for 8.1 miles of Palmyra Township roads, and

WHEREAS, Palmyra Township, through the Township Board, has had plans, and surveys made for the grading, surfacing, and draining of said 8.1 miles of Township road, and

WHEREAS, Palmyra Township through its Township Board, has prepared a W. P. A. Proposal form No. 301 designating the proposal as No. 29 to be sponsored by Douglas County, and

WHEREAS, Palmyra Township requests the Board of Douglas County Commissioners to sponsor the above mentioned project for grading, surfacing, and draining 8.1 miles of Palmyra Township roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Palmyra Township Board, in regular session assembled; that \$7,258.70 in materials, and equipment rental, along with any other costs required of the sponsor, be appropriated, and set aside for the purpose of supplying all necessary Sponsors contributions to the project, as indicated in Column 3 under Item 4 of the Douglas County W.P.A. Proposal No. 29.
