

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

After view made by said Board of County Commissioners in pursuant to Publication Notice in regard to said tract and notice served on land on October 20, 1938, we, the Board of County Commissioners, do find that the condemnation of the above described tract of land was necessary for the purpose of improving Deer Creek and bridge, located $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of Stull, Douglas County, Kansas, and we, do, hereby, appraise the value of the land so taken in the sum of \$8.00 and assess the damages thereto at \$7.00.

James F. Brass moved that the county allow the sum of \$8.00 for land taken, and the sum of \$7.00 for damages, for the Slingerland tract, condemned. Earl T. Black seconded the motion. On vote, all Commissioners voted "Aye".

A Road Petition signed by Petitioner E. H. Griffin and sixteen others was presented to the Board. Said petition is asking for the vacation of a road described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 35- T 14 S, R 17 E; thence north one mile (said road being on the Douglas-Osage County Line) and terminating at the northwest corner of said Sec. 35, T 14 S, R 17 E. (Petition on file in the office of the County Clerk.)

James F. Brass moved that the petition as presented by E. H. Griffin be accepted and that the date of viewing be set for 2 o'clock P. M., Wednesday, November 30, 1938, at the place of beginning. Earl T. Black seconded the motion. On vote, called by the Chairman of the Board, all Commissioners voted "aye".

No further business coming before the Board, said Board adjourned to meet again Monday November 7, 1938.

As per adjournment, the Board of County Commissioners with all Commissioners and the County Clerk present met in the regular meeting rooms of the Board.

Various bills against the county, were, by motion, seconded and voted, allowed this day as recorded on the Allowance Record on file in the County Clerk's office.

The following resolution, pertaining to the Welfare Department, was passed by the Board:

R E S O L U T I O N

Appointing Cleo E. Grimes as Stenographer of the County Social Welfare Board of Douglas County and prescribing compensation. A copy of the personal application record sheet of _____ is attached hereto.

Whereas, the County Social Welfare Board has determined that Cleo E. Grimes is a person properly qualified for her duties:

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the County Social Welfare Board of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular adjourned session assembled:

That Cleo E. Grimes be and is hereby appointed as stenographer in the office of the County Social Welfare Board of Douglas County, Kansas, to hold office at the pleasure of said Board.

Be it further resolved that the total compensation of said Cleo E. Grimes shall be \$60.00 per month, all or part of which may be paid from funds as prescribed by law, provided that before said employee may be paid from such available funds, that said employee is properly qualified for the duties of such position as required by the State Board of Social Welfare of Kansas, in cooperation with any of the various agencies of the Federal Government, under the laws of the State of Kansas and the United States of America and/or rules and regulations prescribed by the State Board of Social Welfare of Kansas.

Be it further resolved that the County shall furnish transportation for authorized travel or shall allow five cents a mile for authorized automobile transportation.
