In regular adjourned session, the Board of County Commissioners met in the meeting rooms of said Board, there being present all members of the Board and the County Clerk.

The Board immediately adjourned to repair to Kansas City to attend the hearing of the K. C., K. V. and W. RR Company, there, also, attending, Mildred LeSuer, County Auditor.

Upon returning from said hearing, the Board of County Commissioners, accompanied by E. E. Trueblood, County Engineer met with the Board of County Commissioners of Osage County, at the hour of 2 o'clock P. M., for the viewing of a road petitioned for by E. H. Griffin and others, praying for vacation of same, at the place of beginning in Marion Township, said road being on the Douglas-Osage County line.

After viewing the above mentioned road, and giving all persons a hearing, it was moved by B. D. Haller, Commissioner of Osage County, that favorable action be taken and the road vacated. A second was made by James F. Brass, Commissioner of Douglas County. On vote, all Commissioners of both county boards, voted "Aye".

The Commissioners returned to the regular meeting rooms for further county business.

Minutes for all meetings during the month of October were read by the Board for its approval. It was moved by Earl T. Black that the minutes be approved as read. A second was made by James F. Brass. On vote, all Commissioners voted in the affirmative.

December 1, 1938.

In the first regular session for the month of December, there assembled in the meeting rooms of the Board, all Commissioners, namely: Chris Schaa, Chairman, Earl T. Black and James F. Brass, Commissioners, and T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk.

Claims against the county for salaries, wages and materials, and claims from the Welfare Department were presented to the Board for its scrutiny and passage. All bills so allowed are recorded on Allowance Record on file with the County Clerk.

The following resolutions were presented to the Board for its passage:

#### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, John C. Emick, J. W. Miller and Chas. E. Louk have heretofore been appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, to appraise the value of tracts and parcels of land abutting in Douglas County on Barker Avenue from the North Line of 15th Street to the North Line of Maple Lawn Addition in the City of Lawrence, said tracts and parcels of land lying outside of the City of Lawrence and said appraisement was made for the purpose of ascertaining assessments to be levied upon each tract or parcel of land to pay the cost of grading, paving, curbing, guttering and otherwise improving said Street, and

WHEREAS, the total cost of such improvements has been ascertained and the total cost of such improvements over and above that paid by the Agencies of the Federal Government is by law to be assessed against the property abutting thereon in proportion to the value of each tract and said appraisers have made the report of their appraisement to this Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the report of the appraisers be and is hereby adopted by said Board of County Commissioners and there are hereby levied for the purpose of paying such costs, special tax assessments on the various tracts of land abutting on said Street as follows:
