The matter of purchasing a Steam shovel for the county was, again, brought up for discussion. Mr. Funk and Mr. Funkhouser, representing the Funkhouser Equip-ment Company, appeared before the Board with the County Engineer and the County Foreman in an effort to make a contract with Douglas County for the sale of a Northwest shovel.
