Bids on an adding machine for the office of the County Clerk were again considered; the two companies bidding are Bullock's and the Lawrence Typewriter Exchange, both bidding on a 10 Column Sundstrand machine with motor, heavy duty, direct subtraction, credit balance 7 inch carriage and stand, both bids at the price of \$265.00.

A motion was made by James F. Brass that the Board accept the bid of the Lawrence Typewriter Exchange for an adding machine as specified above, to be used in the County Clerk's Office. A second was made by Chris Schaake. On vote, all Commissioners voted "Aye".

shovel*

The matter of purchasing a ^{power} steam shovel for the county was, again, brought up for discussion. Mr. Funk and Mr. Funkhouser, representing the Funkhouser Equipment Company, appeared before the Board with the County Engineer and the County Foreman in an effort to make a contract with Douglas County for the sale of a Northwest shovel. All bids, as received on the 28th day of December, were again carefully scrutinized, and after said scrutiny, James F. Brass moved that the contract be awarded to the Funkhouser Equipment Company, Kansas City, Mo., for 1 power shovel, Northwest, crawler type, 3/4 cu. yd, weight 36,000 pounds. Shovel unit complete, including extra attachments and diesel motor. One (1) crane boom, complete for dragline and clamshell work except the dragline bucket and clamshell. One (1) 6000 pound rubber tired trailer, suitable for transporting the above power shovel. Trailer Model No. 25. All F.O.B., Lawrence, Kansas, for the sum of \$9300.00, plus trade-in of old Model 3, Serial No. 2536 3/4 cu. yd Northwest power shovel, less buckets, said sum to be paid from the Road and Bridge Fund of Douglas County upon acceptance of the shovel. A second was made by Chris Schaake. On vote, all Commissioners voted "Aye".

Although discussion was gone into regarding the purchase of a calculator for the County Clerk's Office, no decision was made this day.

No further business appearing before the Board, said Board adjourned.
