The Willow Springs Township Board, George Shuler, Trustee, Otto Hack, Clerk and Harry Hobson, Treasurer, came before the Board in regard to improvements for the Pleasant Grove Road Hill, and seeking information as to whother the County Engineer has, yet, made the survey. The County Engineer, being present, stated that no survey has, yet, been completed, and that nothing definite could be given on it at this time.

Mrs. Pontius and Mrs. Nelson of the Lawrence Women's Club appeared before the Board for a few minutes discussion on the affairs of the club, specifically the matter of the abatement of delinquent taxes against the property owned by said club.

Further bills against the county, as presented by the County Clerk, were by unanimous vote passed by the Commissioners.

A Nursing Committee, consisting of C. E. The Board of County Commissioners met this day in regular adjourned session, there being present: Chairman Chris Schaake, Commissioner Jas. F. Brass and County Clerk T. R. Gerhart.

On motion of Jas. F. Brass, seconded by Chris Schaake, and by unanimous vote, further claims against the county were allowed as recorded on the Allowance Record as of this day.

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, has heretofore authorized the making of certain improvements in the paving, grading, curbing, guttering and otherwise improving 19th Street from the East Line of Barker Avenue to the West Line of Learnard Avenue, and from the Worth Line of 15th Street to the North Line of Maple Lawn Addition on Barker Avenue, and from the Center Line of 19th Street to the South Line of 20th Street on Barkor Avenue, all of said Streets forming a boundary between the City of Lawrence, a City of the second class and outlying tracts and parcels of lands of adjoining the said City in Douglas County, Kansas, the cost of such improve-ments other than that paid by the City of Lawrence and other than that paid by the United States of America to be assessed against the property abutting thereon, and
