RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of January, 1939, the same being a regular adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, the application of Vaughn Chick Pontius, Manager of Lawrence Country Club, for a beer license came on for consideration of said Board, and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that a due and legal notice has been given to the Wakarusa Township Board, and that ten days have expired from the giving of said notice, and that no written objection has been filed by the Wakarusa Township Board, protesting the granting of a beer license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the applicant Vaughn Chick Pontius be granted a license to sell cereal malt beverages for consumption on premises, at the place so described in application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk of Douglas County, be, and he is hereby directed to issue said license.
