RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE FOLLOWING COUNTY OFFICIALS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, TO DEPOSIT ALL MONIES RECEIVED BY THEM IN THEIR OFFICIAL CAPACITIES IN THE BANKS AS DESIGNATED AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, it is required that the Board of County Commissioners comply with Section 9-302-303 General Statutes of Kansas, 1935, designating depositories for all public monies received by county officials in their official capacities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, Douglas County, Kansas, in special session this 26th day of January, 1939, that all county officials named herein deposit all public monies received by them in their official capacities in the banks as designated below, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all banks so listed below shall be the depositories in which monies shall be deposited by said officials of Douglas County, Kansas:
