The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, met in regular session at nine o'clock A. M., February 1, 1939, Earl T. Black, Chairman, presiding, James F. Brass being present, and Chris Schanke.

The following resolution was offered and upon motion duly made and seconded, was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has heretofore issued and now has outstanding the following bonds:

WHEREAS, these bonds all mature prior to March 1, 1940, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has authority under Chapter 14 (Senate Bill No. 116), Session Laws of 1938, and Chapter 10, General Statutes of Kansas, 1935, to refund the above bonds by issuing Refunding bonds in an amount not exceeding the former indebtedness so refunded, and

WHEREAS, it appears to be advisable and to the best interest of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, to refund \$28,000.00 of said indebtedness as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS:

That there are hereby refunded certain bonds of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, more specifically described above, all of which mature prior to March 1, 1940, and which said bonds have been issued by authority of law under the dates above shown, and making a total of \$28,000.00 par value of bonds to be refunded.

That for the purpose of refunding said bonds, there shall be issued Refunding Bonds of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in the sum of \$28,000.00, which issue shall consist of fifty-six bonds, numbered from one to fifty-six, both inclusive, all bonds being in the denomination of \$500.00 each, dated February 1, 1939, and bearing interest at the rate of 1 3/4% per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of May and November each year, after date thereof until paid at maturity, the first coupon, however, becoming due on November 1st, 1939, said principal and interest to be payable at the office of the State Treasurer, Topeka, Kansas, and said bonds shall mature in the following amounts upon the following dates, to-wit:
