KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the County of Douglas of the State of Kansas, for a value received, hereby acknowledges itself to be indebted and promises to pay to the bearer, the sum of

FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS

in lawful money of the United States of America on the first day of November, _____, with interest thereon from and after February 1, 1939, at the rate of one and three-fourths per cent (1 3/4%) per annum, payable semi-annually thereafter on the first days of May and November of each year after the date hereof (except that the first interest coupon on each bond shall become due on November 1, 1939), until said principal sum shall have been paid, upon the presentation and surrender of the coupons hereto annexed, bearing the facsimile signatures of the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and of the County Clerk, as said coupons severally become due, both principal and interest of this bond being payable at the office of the State Treasurer of the State of Kansas, in the City of Topeka, Kansas, and said Douglas County, Kansas, is held and firmly bound by these presents, and its faith and credit, and all of the real and personal property within the jurisdiction of said Douglas County are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of said principal and interest at maturity.

This bond is one of a series of fifty-six bonds of like date and tenor, excepting maturity, aggregating the principal sum of \$28,000.00, issued by said Douglas County, Kansas, for the purpose of refunding a like principal amount of bonds of said Douglas County becoming due prior to March 1, 1940, in full compliance with the provisions, restrictions and limitation of the constitution and laws of the State of Kansas, including Article 1 of Chapter 10, General Statutes of Kansas, 1935, and all amendments thereof, and Senate Bill 116, Laws of Kansas, 1938, Special Session, and all other provisions of the laws of said state, and this bond and all of the other bonds of said series, and all interest thereon, are to be paid by the said Douglas County, Kansas.

And it is hereby declared and certified that all acts, conditions and things required to be done and to exist precedent to and in the issuance of this bond have been properly done and performed and do exist in due and regular form and manner as required by the constitution and the laws of the State of Kansas, and that the total indebtedness of said Douglas County, Kansas, including this series of bonds, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, said Douglas County, by its Board of County Commissioners, has caused this bond to be signed by its Chairman, attested by its Clerk and Countersigned by its Treasurer, and its seal to be hereto affixed, and the coupons hereto attached to be signed with the facsimile signatures of said Chairman and Clerk, and this bond to be dated this first day of February, 1939.
