Below is the final action as taken on the Sim Delan Road:

WE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS. Acting under the Laws of 1923, Chapter 68, Article 114, which reads as follows, "PROCEEDINGS FOR CHANGES IN ROADS. When it is found necessary to lay out, relocate, alter, widen or vacate a road or highway for the purpose of eliminating sharp turns or other dangerous places, or for the proper construction of a highway, or for the extension of a bridge or culvert, the board of county commissioners shall by order of said Board lay out, relocate, alter, or widen a public road and may vacate an existing road. All land required for the laying out, widening or altering of a road shall be acquired by the board of county commissioners by purchase or by donation."

We, do hereby order the change in Township Road No. 173, in or between Sections 9 and 16, Township 12 S, Range 20 E, laid out new and vacated short section of old road #173 as per sketch attached, and acting as VIEWERS, do hereby order that the route as surveyed under our direction by E. E. Trueblood, COUNTY Surveyor, assisted by C. E. Redmond and George Moorman, chairman, is for the public good and convenience.

Be it hereby ordered by the Board of County Commissioners that these proceedings and the report of survey be recorded.

It is also ordered that the Trustee of Grant Township be directed to cause the road opened for public use.

The following resolution was passed by the Board of County Commissioners:

WE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, acting under Chapter 68 paragraph 108 of the General Statutes of the State of Kansas, 1935, as reviewers of the south one mile of old road #412, on which there are no definite field notes of location on record, do hereby order the County Surveyor to make a resurvey of said mile of road through section 11 township 15 south, range 18 east, locating the road as near as possible and practical on the present traveled right-of-way, maintaining a 40 foot road; make plat and field notes of the same and file them with the county road records same as a new road. We further order all right-of-way other than that shown on the attached plat be vacated.
