The Board of County Commissioners with all members present and the County Clerk met in regular adjourned session at the hour of 9 o'clock A. M.

The following resolutions were, by motion, properly seconded and voted, passed:

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Arthur Tarpay did on the 5th day of July, 1939, plead guilty in the Justice Court of C. C. Rankin to the crime of possession of intoxicating liquors and was fined, on said charge, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and costs of Nine Dollars and Twenty-five Cents (\$9.25).

AND WHEREAS, under the laws of Kansas, more particularly Section 62-1515 G. S., 1935, give authority to The Board of County Commissioners to discharge from imprisonment any persons imprisoned for failure to pay any fine or costs upon satisfactory proof to them that said person is unable to pay the same, provided, however, that said discharge shall not release said person from his liability to pay said fine and costs.

AND WHEREAS, it is duly shown to the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the said Arthur Tarpay is unable to pay the fine and costs assessed against him.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the said Arthur Tarpay be released and discharged from imprisonment, provided, however, that the said Arthur Tarpay shall not be released from his liability to pay said fine and costs, and that the said Arthur Tarpay shall be required to pay the said fine and costs as soon as he is able to do so.

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Frank Tate did on the 17th day of July, 1939, plead guilty in the Justice Court of C. C. Rankin to the crime of driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquors and was fined, on said charge, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and costs of Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$7.50), and the said Frank Tate did on the 24th day of July, 1939, plead guilty in the Justice Court of C. C. Rankin to the crime of petty larceny and was fined, on said charge, the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and costs of Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$7.50).

AND WHEREAS, under the laws of Kansas, more particularly Section 62-1515 G.
