

The following is the contract between the Board of County Commissioners and the Wm. J. Burns, International Detective Agency, Inc., signed by the Board this day:

CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE WILLIAM J. BURNS
INTERNATIONAL DETECTIVE AGENCY, INC.
and
DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS.

This contract entered into by and between the William J. Burns International Detective Agency, Inc. and Douglas County, Kansas, provides that said William J. Burns International Detective Agency, Inc. will furnish ten (10) men to work under the directions of officials of Douglas County, Kansas, at the National Corn Husking Contest to be held in Douglas County, Kansas on November 3rd.

It is further agreed that Douglas County, Kansas, agrees to pay the William J. Burns International Detective Agency, Inc., ten dollars(\$10.00) per day for each of the ten (10) men engaged and will also pay their bus fares from Kansas City, Missouri to Lawrence, Kansas, and their bus fares from Lawrence, Kansas, back to Kansas City, Missouri, making a total of \$112.00.

It is further agreed that there will be no extra charge for the William J. Burns International Detective Agency, Inc. Crime Prevention Signs which may be displayed on and near the premises of the Corn Husking Contest mentioned above.
