By the proper motion, second and vote, the bid of the Baldwin Ledger for publication of the second group of Judicial Tax Sale notices, at the price of 24¢ for first insertion and 11¢ for succeeding insertions, was accepted, they being the low bidder.

By motion made by Chris Schaae and with a second and unanimous vote, the contract for the furnishing of four (4) tax rolls for 1940 to the county, was let to the World Company at their low bid of \$159.50.

Said petition prays for the widening of the above described road from 48' to 50'. After careful consideration to the matter, the Board unanimously granted the request as set out in the petition. It was moved by Chris Schaae that the bid of the Manley Insurance Agency, in the amount of \$60.13, for insurance on all county cars, be accepted, said company being low bidder. A second was made by Jas. F. Brass. On vote, called by Chairman Earl T. Black; all commissioners voted in the affirmative.

November 18, 1939.

In regular adjourned session this 18th day of November, 1939, all members of the Board of County Commissioners met in the regular meeting rooms of said Board; there being present, also, T. R. Gerhart, County Clerk.

The Board immediately adjourned to attend a meeting in Topeka with WPA authorities, accompanied by the County Engineer and the Welfare Director.

At the hour of 1:30 P.M., once again said Board convened to attend to other county business.

Asa Colman, Bindweed Supervisor reported to the Board that he would need about 1000 pounds more of sodium chlorate to finish the treatment of bindweed for this year. Although, discussion was given to this matter, no definite action was taken.

Mrs. Mildred LeSuer, Budget Director, gave a report on the cash and budget balances.

A road petition, signed by Mrs. Barbara V. Kennedy as Petitioner, and eleven others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners. Said petition is praying for the location of a road described as: Beginning at the NE corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T 14 S, R 19 E; Thence west along north line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ section one-half mile, and terminating at the NW corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T 14 S, R 19 E. The petition, being in proper order and finding no objections, it was moved by Jas. F. Brass that the Board accept the road petition of Mrs. Barbara V. Kennedy et al, praying for the location of a road described above; and that the time for viewing be set Wednesday, December 13, 1939, at the hour of 2 o'clock P. M.. Chris Schaae seconded the motion. On vote, motion carried by affirmative vote.

Another road petition, signed by R. E. Schroyer and fourteen others was considered; said petition praying for the vacation of a road beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner on east line of Sec. 14, T 12 S, R 18 E; thence west one mile through Sec. 14, T 12 S, R 18 E, and terminating at the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner on west line of said Sec. 14. In lieu of this vacation, widen from 40 feet to 60 feet, one mile of old road and improve same, beginning at the SE corner of Sec. 14, T 12 S, R 18 E; thence west one mile and terminating at the SW corner of said Sec. 14, which point is in an all weather surfaced road.

It was moved by Jas F. Brass that the above petition be accepted, and that the time for viewing be set for 2 o'clock P. M., Wednesday, December 20, 1939. Chris Schaae seconded the motion. On vote, all Commissioners voted "Aye".
