Details concerning this new plan were carefully gone into, and it was thought best to start on same the first of February.

Final action was taken on the Barbara Kennedy road, which had been petition for the location of same as follows: Beginning at the NE cor of  $SE_4^1$  of Sec. 12, T 14 S, R 19 E; thence west along north line of said  $\frac{1}{4}$  section, one-half mile, and terminating at the NW corner of  $SE_4^1$  of Sec. 12, T 14 S. R 19 E.

It was moved by Jas. F. Brass that the Barbara Kennedy road petition be denied, because the law gives the Board no authority to grant same, unless the petitioner stands the entire cost of the location of said road. Chris Schaake seconded the moiton. On vote, called by the Chairman, all Commissioners voted "Aye".

Final Action of the Board of County Commissioners on the Road Petitioned for by R. E. Schroyer and Others:

The petition of R. E. Schroyer and others for the establishment--alteration--vacation of a road being under consideration of the Board for final action, it is determined and ordered by the Board that the public good and convenience does require that said road as viewed, located and surveyed be vacated.

We determine and order the width of the substituted road shall be 60 feet.

And it hereby so ordered by the Board and that these proceedings and the report of survey be recorded. It is also ordered that the Trustee of Lecompton Township be directed to cause the vacated road closed for public use, and the County Engineer ordered to open the substitute road for public use.
