The County Engineer, E. E. Trueblood, discussed the vacating of a section of an old 40 foot road, No. 421 in Marion Township. By motion of Chris Schaake, second of Jas. F. Brass and unanimous vote, said section of road was ordered vacated. Pursuant thereto, the following order was issued:

WE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, acting under the laws of 1923, Chapter 68 Article 114, which reads as follows, "PROCEEDINGS FOR CHANGES IN ROADS". When it is found necessary to lay out, relocate, alter, widen or vacate a road or highway for the purpose of eliminating sharp turns, or other dangerous places, or for the proper construction of a highway, or for the extension of a bridge or culvert, the Board of County Commissioners shall by order of said Board layout, relocate, alter or widen a public road, and may vacate an existing road. All land required for the laying out, widening or altering of a road shall be acquired by the board of county commissioners by purchase or donation.

Therefore we do hereby, order the vacation of a section of old 40 foot road No. 421, beginning at a point 272.7 feet West of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner on the East line of Section 12-T14S-R18E, thence North 88 Deg. 57 min. West 445.25 feet more or less to the East right of way line of the present re-located road No. 421, also vacate a section of old 40 foot road No. 647, beginning at a point 272.7 feet West of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner on the East line of Section 12-T14S-R18E, thence South 11 Deg. 25 min. West 660 feet more or less to a point in the East right of way line of the re-located road No. 421.

Both sections of the above vacated roads lay in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 12-T14S-R18E, as shown on plan attached, and are superseded by the re-located road No. 421.

It is also ordered that the County Engineer of Douglas County be directed to cause the said sections of vacated road to be closed for public use.
