## REPORT

In the matter of acquiring an additional strip of land ten feet wide by about one-half mile long, laying along the South side of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 14-T12S-R18E by Eminent Domain and condemnation, for the purpose of widening the present road from 40 feet to 60 feet.

We, the undersigned Board of Douglas County Commissioners acting as viewers, and accompanied by the County Engineer, and County Clerk, appeared at the S.W. corner of said section 14-T12S-R18E, at 2 o'clock P. M., March 6th, 1940, as specified in the public notice; here we met C. S. Winter, representative for the interested parties.

Accompanied by said representative we proceeded to view the necessary ten foot strip of land to be acquired, and appraised same at the rate of \$45.00 per acre, and award \$27.00 for the six tenths of an acre, taken, and all other damages, except
