The Board of County Commissioners adjourned to sit as the Board of Social Welfare, to take action as per the following motion. After so doing, said Board immediately re-convened as the Board of County Commissioners;

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, acting as the Board of Social Welfare, has received the resignation of Dr. H. P. Jones as County Physician for the care of the indigent poor of Douglas County,

AND WHEREAS, the proposed contract with the members of the Douglas County Medical Society, which it had been hoped would be effective on December 1, 1940, has not yet been approved by the State Board of Social Welfare,

AND WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County now finds it necessary to make arrangements for continued medical care of its welfare cases until such time as the proposed contract shall become effective;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners employ Dr. H. P. Jones as County Physician until such time as the proposed contract with the Douglas County Medical Society shall become effective, at the regular monthly salary of \$125.00 plus necessary mileage which has been the agreement heretofore; and in addition, \$2.00 per necessary home visit or call to approved welfare cases which may be made by Dr. Jones or his approved assistants.

J. M. Sanderson moved that the foregoing resolution be adopted. Jas. F. Brass, seconded the motion. On vote, called by Chairman Earl T. Black, all commissioners voted "Aye".

Assessor Fey failed to apply exemption.

All members of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk met in regular adjourned session.

At this time John E. Stephens, Acting County Engineer, presented new bids on a concrete mixer for the Engineering Department:

J. M. Sanderson moved that the county purchase the concrete mixer from the Victor L. Phillips Company, they being the low bidder, at the net price of \$1045.00. Jas. F. Brass seconded the motion. On vote, all Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

In the discussion on the scales, the Acting County Engineer stated that the scales bidden on by the G. W. Van Kepple Company were in excellent condition, and were just as good as any new scales. This seemed to be his preference. Therefore, Jas. F. Brass moved that the scales as bidden on by the G. W. Van Kepple Company, in the amount of \$151.00 be purchased. J. M. Sanderson seconded the motion. On vote, called by Chairman Black, all commissioners voted "Aye".

The Board gave John E. Stephens authority to purchase the above equipment.
