At the appointed hour Ralph Colman, Republican and Olin Button, Democrat, who received tie votes for the office of Treasurer in Kanwaka Township at the General Election, held November 5, 1940, appeared before the Board of County Commissioners to determine by lot, which of the men should be elected to said office. The method decided upon was the drawing of straws from between the pages of a book, the longer straw to denote the winner. After said drawing the following resolution went on record:

Whereas, it appears that at the General Election, held on November 5, 1940, a tie vote resulted for the office of Kanwaka Township Treasurer, wherein Ralph Colman, Republican received 174 votes for the office of Kanwaka Township Treasurer, and Olin Button, Democrat, received 174 votes for the office of Kanwaka Township Treasurer.

On this 18th day of December, both Colman and Button did appear before the Board of County Commissioners and the question of who should fill the office of Treasurer was decided by lot, and Ralph Colman was declared elected.

No. 216*** CANCEL 1940 Personal Property tax in the amount of 55 cents, based on a valuation of \$30.00, charged to Wes Davault, Route #3, Baldwin, Palmyra Township, School District 39-1.

Assessor Van Tries failed to allow exemption.

CANCEL 1940 Dog tax in the amount of \$1.00, charged to Carl Kurtz, Route #1, Eudora, Eudora, Township, School District #5, RHS #2.

Was assessed for two dogs. Had but one as assessor's slip shows.

No. 218*** CANCEL 1940 Dog tax in the amount of \$1.00, charged to Cordelia Mitchell, 336 Elm, Lawrence.

Duplicate assessment. This dog was assessed, also, to Daniel Baker, the father of Cordelia Mitchell, of the same address.

CANCEL 1940 Personal Property tax in the amount of \$4.07, based on a tangible valuation of \$150.00, charged to Mrs. Nellie Anderson, 1642 Barker, Wakarusa Township, School District #60.

Assessment sheet signed "Assessor", not by Mrs. Anderson, who moved from address prior to assessment period.
