Sheriff Banning appeared before the Commissioners, and the Board informed him that it had made no reduction in his bond, but went on record to the effect that same should remain as is, namely, \$10,000. Mr. Banning, asked that some consideration be given to salary increases for Cecil Georgie, Night Jailer and Ernest Pohl, Deputy Sheriff stationed in Baldwin. Mr. Georgie is now receiving \$50.00 per month and Mr. Pohl is receiving \$100.00 per month, out of which he has to pay for his mileage while on duty for the county. These requests were taken under advisement.

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE FOLLOWING COUNTY OFFICIALS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, TO DEPOSIT ALL MONIES RECEIVED BY THEM IN THEIR OFFICIAL CAPACITIES IN THE BANKS AS DESIGNATED AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, it is required that the Board of County Commissioners comply with Section 9-302-303 General Statutes of Kansas, 1935, designating depositories for all public monies received by county officials in their official capacities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, Douglas County, Kansas, in regular adjourned session this 29th day of January, 1941, that all county officials named herein deposit all public monies received by them in their official capacities in the banks as designated below, and
