

## COMMISSIONER'S RECORD N

Douglas County Republican, Lawrence

Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Both Clark Morton of the Lawrence Roofing Company and J. D. Seiler from the Seiler Roofing Company appeared before the Commissioners to discuss the bids for the new roof of the jail. Mr. Morton recommended that asphalt be used while Mr. Seiler recommended the use of tar.

The following resolution in regard to the use of the county's share of sales tax for welfare was passed:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, under House Bill No. 105 of the Special Session Laws of Kansas, 1937, the Board of County Commissioners is empowered by resolution to direct the County Treasurer to credit all or any portion of the County's share of such sales tax distribution as a political subdivision to the County's Social Welfare Fund or to a bond and interest fund to be used in the payments of bonds and interest thereon theretofore issued to obtain funds used in carrying on social welfare activities, and

WHEREAS, it appears that it would be to the best interest of Douglas County to direct the County Treasurer to credit all of its share from said distribution to the County's Social Welfare Fund for use of social welfare purposes during the current county budget year, 1941.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners as the Board of Social Welfare of Douglas County, Kansas, that the County Treasurer be and is hereby directed to credit all of its share as a political subdivision of sales tax distribution which Douglas County may receive under the provisions of House Bill 105 to the County's Social Welfare Fund for use for social welfare purposes during the current county budget year, 1941.

The Board also passed the following resolution, requesting benefits from the State Emergency Social Welfare Fund:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, under Chapter 205 of the Session Laws of 1939, provides that any county which has levied three mills for social welfare purposes for the current county budget year may request the State Board of Social Welfare to pay to the county additional benefits from the State Emergency Social Welfare Fund, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 334 Session Laws of 1939 appropriates to the State Emergency Social Welfare Fund \$80,000.00 for January and February 1941 distribution, and

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Board of Social Welfare in their budget for 1941 show the need of emergency fund in the amount of \$8,472.00 for welfare expenditures in addition to the amount secured by a three mill levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners as the Board of Social Welfare of Douglas County, Kansas, do hereby request the State Board of Social Welfare to pay to Douglas County benefits from this fund.
