

## COMMISSIONER'S RECORD N

Douglas County Republican, Lawrence

Hereby request that you constitute the same as a sewer district, and since this district will be adjacent to the sewer serving Sewer District No. 1, it is requested that you constitute that portion of the main sewer serving Sewer District No. 1, from its connection with the Lawrence City Sewer System to its Western end in the Township road, on the North side of the Tract above described, a distance of 3082 feet as a joint sewer.

And that the owners of the land in the District to be created hereunder, be required to pay in to the County Clerk, the sum of \$848.00 which sum would be their prorata part of the cost of such sewer jointly used. The \$848.00 in turn to be paid to the owners of property in Sewer District No. 1, when said Sewer in District No. 1 was built and in proportion as the cost thereof was assessed against the parcels of land in said Sewer District No. 1.

We further agree that the Board of County Commissioners may enter into such a contract with the Governing Body of the City of Lawrence, as was made with it on May 28th, 1936 with respect to the connection of Sewer District No. 1 with the sewer system of the City of Lawrence.

As per adjournment, all members of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk met in regular adjourned session this 24th day of March, 1941.

By unanimous vote of the Board, the following resolution was passed:

#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS a Petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in accordance with Sec. 19-2704 G. S. 1935 and Amendments thereto, signed by Ina L. Spencer, Charline Fitzpatrick and E. M. Cameron, being the owners of One Hundred Per Cent (100%) of the land acreage in the following described real estate:

Lots 1 to 29 inclusive, 44 to 51 inclusive, and 55 in Grand View Place, the Plat of which is on file with the Petition for the proposed district. Said Plat is a portion of the West one-half of the North one-half of the Northwest one-quarter of Section One (1), Township Thirteen (13), Range Nineteen (19), Douglas County, Kansas,

requesting that a sewer district be formed within the boundaries of the above described real estate, and that a sewer system be constructed therein;

AND WHEREAS the said proposed sewer district is adjacent to a sewer serving Sewer District No. 1, it is requested by said Petition that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas constitute that portion of the main sewer serving Sewer District No. 1 from its connection with the Lawrence city sewer system, a distance of 3082 feet, as a joint sewer;

AND WHEREAS the owners of the land in the proposed district have agreed to pay all of the cost incident to the establishment and construction of said sewer system and to pay into the county clerk the sum of \$848.00, which sum to be their pro rata part of the cost of such sewer jointly used; the \$848.00 in turn to be paid to the owners of property in Sewer District No. 1, when said sewer in District No. 1 was built and in proportion as the costs thereof was assessed against the parcels of land in said Sewer District No. 1, provided, however, that where affected property has been conveyed while assessments were being paid, then refund will be made on a proportionate basis;

AND WHEREAS a preliminary engineering survey has been made and a finding has been made that said sewer district would be practical and beneficial;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled, this 24th day of March, 1941, that said proposed sewer district should be and is hereby created within the boundaries of the above described real estate, the said district to be designated as Sewer District No. 2; and that the portion of the main sewer serving Sewer District No. 1 from its connection with the Lawrence city sewer system a distance of 3082 feet is hereby constituted a joint sewer provided however, that all costs incident to the establishment and construction of said sewer system to be paid by the owners of the land in Sewer District No. 2;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, enter into an agreement with the governing body of the City of Lawrence with respect to the connecting of said sewer with the sewer system of the City of Lawrence in line with the provisions of this resolution;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after this resolution has been adopted and within five days after a contract has been signed by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and the
