WHEREAS, there is now pending before the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, the matter of a certain road petition for the location of one certain public township road in Douglas County, Kansas, running from U. S. Highway No. 40 to the South boundary of the property owned by the Lawrence Country Club, the legal description being more particularly set out in said road petition, and
