August 30, 1941.

As per adjournment, all members of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk met in regular adjourned session in the regular meeting rooms of said Board.

Mrs. Cecile Roglitz from Topeka, met with the Board to ask for a compromise on real estate tax levied on her property, known as Lot 150, Louisiana Street. She has paid the taxes for 1938, 1939 and first half of 1940. Taxes for 1933, 1934, 1935, 1936 and 1937 are delinquent. The amount of taxes plus penalties and interest up to September 1, 1941 is \$444.43. Mrs. Roglitz says that Shawnee County is compromising on taxes, taking off about 30%. Douglas County has never established the precedent of compromising real estate tax.

The County Attorney informed the Board that if such a compromise were entered into, the law compels the county board to have the written consent of the City, providing the property is within the city limits. After some discussion, the Board decided that no compromise be made.

For a wiring change of the courthouse and jail made necessary for the purpose of connecting the jail service with that of the courthouse, both to be on one meter, the following bids were received and opened:

Since the rush season for the sale of fishing licenses at the Lone Star Lake is over, the Board went on record terminating the services of Mrs. Harry S. Gregg, who has been acting as extra clerical help in the selling of these licenses.

J. M. Sanderson moved that the employment of Mrs. Harry S. Gregg, for the sole purpose of extra clerical help during the rush season of the sale of fishing licenses at the Lone Star Lake, be terminated September 6, 1941, and that she be notified by letter. Ed Johnson seconded the motion. On vote, said motion carried by affirmative vote.
