

*Bids for labor  
in construction of sewer  
awarded to J. T. Constant*

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, on July 15, 1941, bids for necessary labor and materials for the construction of a sewer in Sewer District No. 2, Douglas County, Kansas, were received and opened, and

WHEREAS, it appeared that the bid of J. T. Constant, Contractor, was low and in accordance with specifications; and so being, was accepted by the unanimous approval of the Board of County Commissioners, and contract duly awarded, and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 1941, a written request for non-execution of said contract was filed with the Board by interested parties, namely, Ina S. Spencer, Daniel H. Spencer, Estelle D. Cameron, Edward M. Cameron and Charline Fitzpatrick, and

WHEREAS, in a regular adjourned meeting on September 10, 1941, there appeared interested parties, Ina S. Spencer, Daniel H. Spencer and J. T. Constant, Contractor; and upon the verbal request of the County Board, said J. T. Constant consented to the cancellation of the contract for the construction of a sewer in Sewer District No. 2, and further agreed to make no charges against the Sewer District for materials ordered for the purpose of this work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the written request of the above named parties be granted and pursuant thereto the contract awarded to J. T. Constant, Contractor, be cancelled.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the certified check on file and previously submitted by said J. T. Constant be returned to the Contractor.
