As per adjournment, all members of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk met in regular adjourned session this day.

Cancellation Order No. 234 was passed: "CANCEL personal property tax for 1941 in the amount of \$9.20, based on a valuation of \$245.00; and cancel said valuation of \$245.00, charged to Anna Brickley, 1315 Kentucky Street, Lawrence, on Page 260, Line 19, Lawrence City Tax Roll.

In lieu thereof, enter the valuation of \$45.00 with tax \$1.69.

Deputy Assessor failed to give \$200.00 constitutional exemption. "

Mrs. E. M. Tenny appeared before the Board to protest her taxes which she says are too high, her complaint based on the school levy. The Board informed her that the Board could do nothing about this levy.

In regard to the agreement on the payment of the delinquent taxes against the Kansas City, Kaw Valley and Western Railroad, the Board by motion of J. M. Sanderson, seconded by Ed Johnson and passed by unanimous vote, passed the following resolution.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Kansas City, Kaw Valley and Western Railroad Company have made an application to compromise certain delinquent taxes of that company owing to Douglas County, Kansas, for the years 1930 to 1938 inclusive;

AND WHEREAS, the delinquent taxes owed by said company are as follows:

plus interest and penalties for each year;

AND WHEREAS, said compromise proposal provided for the payment of \$100.00 each year in full settlement of the taxes due for one year, said payment to be made at the same time that payment was made paying the current taxes due, said current taxes to be paid in full for the year 1939 and subsequent years;

AND WHEREAS, said proposal was submitted to the Federal District Court of Kansas in a re-organization proceeding in said Court affecting said Kansas City, Kaw Valley and Western Railroad Company, Case No. 7582, and said proposal was accepted by the Court and made an Order of the Court in said case;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that said Board agrees to accept the proposal submitted for the payment of delinquent taxes in accordance with the Order of the Court, and that the said delinquent taxes against the Kansas City, Kaw Valley and Western Railroad Company be settled and compromised in full in the following manner: by the payment of nine payments of \$100.00 each, in full satisfaction of the taxes due from said company for the years 1930 to 1938 inclusive, said payments are to be made in the following manner: \$100.00 at the time that the taxes due for 1939 are paid, and said 1939 taxes to be paid in full in addition to the \$100.00 payment; a payment of \$100.00 at the time the 1940 taxes are paid, said 1940 taxes being paid in full in addition to the \$100.00 payment, and so on each year a payment of \$100.00 at the time of the payment of the current taxes in full until all of said nine payments of \$100.00 are made.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event the current taxes for the year 1939 or any subsequent year are not paid in full when due, or in the event of the failure to make the payment each year of \$100.00 as outlined above, then in that event, the said compromise plan shall become inoperative and the delinquent taxes for the years 1930 to 1938 inclusive shall become due and payable in full with interest and penalties as provided by law.
